Fighting gender stereotypes

Intercultural dialogue can help in the dismantling stereotypes which hinder women's full role within their societies by constructing new and varied images of them as agents for the promotion of intercultural dialogue and change in the region. A large majority of the EuroMed population concur that women should participate more in the fields of technology, science, business, culture, education and media. In contrast, only 39% of the SEM population agrees that women should be more involved in politics, as opposed to 53% of the European population. A vast majority in SEM countries believes that women should have a greater role in looking after the children and the house (80%) as opposed to 22% of the European population.
