



ARCIRAGAZZI PORTICI "UTOPIA ATTANASIO"

We carry out a series of activities at local/National and International level for disseminating knowledge of children's rights among minors, young people and adults (referring to the 1989 UN Convention). The core objective pursued by Arciragazzi is the social inclusion by shaping access to resources and opportunities for all young people including youth with few opportunities, minors in care system, youth with migrant background, LGBT young people. From 2011, due to the constant and deep cooperation with Shannara Social Cooperative (www.cooperativashannara.it), dealing with minors at risk, unaccompanied foreign minors and young girls from the trafficking, we manage to go through different topics and to encourage young people to be the protagonist and motivate them to be agents of social change. The know-how acquired in the design activities and projects (such as training courses, exchange of good practices, study visits, youth exchanges, ESC...) within the Euro-Mediterranean framework related to migration topics, Arciragazzi has developed good practise in the promotion of a cohesive society, allowing us to broaden our knowledge, providing opportunities for minors and young people (autochthones and migrants) to gain experience outside the local context; to allow adults professional updating dealing with youth; building strategic partnerships for the implementation and study of good practices of interventions in the migration area, in particular unaccompanied foreign minors and young migrants, and the services necessary to achieve a good reception to the local context of the newly. Then, this spectrum of actions has allowed us to build a specific identity at National level (Arciragazzi counts about 50 youth centres located in different Italian region/cities) and from different private and public bodies.

"Our Gold" Youth Exchange has been selected as "best practice" for the BpE (Becoming a part of Europe) by the Italian ANG for international activities with impact on young migrants, asylum seekers and refugees inside the local community, using the principles and approaches of non-formal learning and representing youth work experiences and practices as a tool for social inclusion. Therefore, the social communication has a broad collective aims and it plays a fundamental rule. On line and offline awareness campaigns and socially relevant initiatives are led by the youth group involved. They are carried out through our association social profiles or in the streets and squares with events that aim to raise awareness among young and adult citizens and by using photography, reading, music, video boxes, posters, "social guerrilla" and audiovisual as powerful tools to engage them in reflective and independent thinking. Arciragazzi Portici is the territorial antenna for No Hate Speech Network, it's a member at ENAR (European anti-racism network) and it's a representative at Municipality of Portici for the Equal Opportunities Territorial Commission.

EXILE (FRANCE) YOUTH EXCHANGE

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2020, 23/29 February: SEEDS (Oviedo, Spain)

Project funded by the European Commission Erasmus + Directorate of General Education and Culture "SEEDS" is a Partnership Building Activity (PBA) that will gather 26 participants from 16 organizations and 13 countries. Through this PBA we aim to put in contact different organizations that are interested in creating mobility projects with youngsters with fewer opportunities. It intends to create a space to connect organizations from different geographical areas, with the purpose of understanding their local realities and the work they carry out as well as sharing tools and good practices in Youth Work with young people with fewer opportunities.

The project will consist of 2 mobilities, training for trainers and evaluation meeting, which will include 4 different phases – preparation and research, residential training for trainers, development and implementation of the follow up activities and finally residential evaluation meeting.

The aim was to make visible the LGBT immigrants and LGBT inmates to show the lack of integration policy at National, European and worldwide level.

2019, 20-30 November : XI Festival del Cinema dei Diritti Umani Napoli

The XI Edition presents, for the first time, the Youth section open to works created by authors under 25 years or addressed to an audience of children and/or young people up to 25 years of age. Arciragazzi, in June, started to promote the Festival through its National and International network and a youth group of 8 people with different background, took place as jury along with other young people of different NGOs to evaluate the short movies participating to the call.

2019, 25 November: International Day for the eradication of violence against women

The day was characterized by two meetings. The first meeting was that of with a group of young people from different countries who discussed about the analysis of the words hurting them when comes to discrimination, gender equality and gender-based violence.

The second one was structured within a simulation activity scheduled for the XI HUMAN RIGHTS FESTIVAL IN NAPLES - YOUTH session. The vision of three videos gave us the opportunity to "read" the hidden messages and of which we are the bearers (sometimes involuntarily) on discrimination, gender inequality and gender violence.

2019, 15 Novembre-15 June 2020: ESC – European Solidarity Corps: CROSSING VIEW IV

«Crossing views» is based on the values of mutual learning and on the idea that we are more creative and innovative in intercultural environments. In this sense, this project will give intercultural learning opportunities to volunteers so they can improve their work as youth workers but it will also focus on the learning benefits that the hosting organisation can get of this cooperation.

and training in the field of gender and in particular focusing on the phenomenon of violence against women and addressed to young people.

2018, 5/11 NOVEMBRE: Dealing with refugees (Amman, Giordania)

Organizer: Salto-Youth EuroMed (SALTO), National Agencies of Erasmus + of following countries: France, Italy, Finland, UK, Norway and with Salto Youth Cultural Diversity.

The experiential practice highlighted some areas that could be developed within the Erasmus+ Youth in Action Programme: The role of youth work in dealing with refugees (by different actors, such as NGOs, municipalities, youth work organisations, institutions, etc.); Practices on empowerment and social cohesion, inclusion of refugees at local level, and on community dimension; A networking space for the participating organisations for future cooperation at international level.

The objectives were: To provide an experiential follow-up activity to the Dealing with Refugees: from challenges to opportunities conference in local NGOs active in the field in Jordan; To share experiences and practices of local youth work with refugees among participants to improve quality; To create a space to conceive and prepare Erasmus+ Youth in Action projects to put inspirations/ideas that come up during the seminar into practice, using experiences from encounters during the seminar activities.

2018, September to 2020 February: KA2 - UpGrad_ME

Project funded by the European Commission Erasmus + Directorate of General Education and Culture

UpGrad_Me is a project whose aim was to develop contents capable to enhance migrant youth employability by building their capacity. The motto "self-branding through a Video CV using your mobile phone" was the acknowledgement by the partners involved of the fact that migrant youths at risk of social exclusion and poverty do not possess a computer, but have all a smart phone, whose potentials are ignored for low awareness in digital literacy. So, included in the learning outcome of the training is the capacity to harness the power of their mobile phone, an element which was also one of the objectives of the project.

2018, 6/9 February: Awareness campaign against CYBERBULLISM - No Hate Speech (Portici, Napoli)

The Action Day (Action Days) is characterized as a day of activism during which activists from all the National Campaigns will be mobilized simultaneously in 44 countries and will carry out online and / or offline activities around the specific focus of the day, and according to the contents suggested by the EUROPEAN ONLINE ACTIVIST group registered and recognized by the Council of Europe. Arciragazzi Portici as Territorial Coordinator of the No Hate Speech Movement Italia will take care of an awareness campaign on social profiles such as FACEBOOK. The activity is based on the identification of examples of Cyberbullying - Hate Speech, report them on the social network and, if necessary, interview the victims of the same, if they find the possibility.

2018, January: M.I.RA - Mobilità Internazionale per RAgazzi (Portici, Naples)

Territorial promotion self-financed and promoted by Arciragazzi and Portici Youth Forum.

Activity: M.I.RA is a project conceived by Arciragazzi Portici and the Portici Youth Forum. Born from the desire to promote international mobility among young people residing in the territory of Portici and surrounding areas, to encourage learning experiences (such as study experiences, work and / or apprenticeship) in multicultural environments, thus facilitating paths of inclusion, equity and integration. The current social, linguistic and cultural diversity that involves all the Member States, makes it necessary to create transversal skills such as intercultural, social and civic and linguistic skills, to foster integration and comparison between the different European and non-European realities: this need is in fact imposed by the Multicultural Society, which has been consolidated over the years and which now involves all citizens and residents in the Member States. The event aims to involve not only students but also young people with migration backgrounds and with few opportunities to facilitate the process of inclusion, equity and integration, thus aiming for social cohesion paths through activities of common interest.

"OUR GOLD" international youth project was organized by Arciragazzi Portici, the Italian leading partner, along with other European and South-Mediterranean partner associations. The project involved 7 countries and 70 young people. The project has consisted of two phases: the first one was held in Italy in July and the second one in Tunisia in September 2016, hosted by the Tunisian partner CCAB – Club Culturel Ali Belihoune. The main activities were based on a series of sessions and workshops to discuss issues related to religion phobia, from hate speech to stereotypes and common considerations that leaked the information - disinformation by media. The youth exchanges involved also journalists, an Italian Senator, a Member of the Tunisian Parliament, a Tunisian philosopher, an Islamic Association in Napoli, different associations helping with young migrants and youth, educators, cultural mediators, lawyers and mostly young migrants (with different cultural backgrounds) as testimonials on discussion tables. The main objective of the Youth Exchanges was based on "No HateSpeech" movement that is launched by the Council of Europe – Youth Department to create suitable tools to break down prejudices, raising public awareness on issues related to minorities, to empower youth to gain awareness and competences regarding the inclusion of young people with different beliefs into their community and a critical thought process about media pressure. In this project, every participant, in the collective and individual ways, reflected about their feelings when they felt targeted by a "hate speech". Different labels came up in the workshops to be discussed and analyzed critically, such as Mafioso, Black, Muslim, Woman, etc. And along with those labels, of course, different topics came out too.
